



BONEFISH E2'S WAY

Aitutaki

The stunning Aitutaki lagoon is home to some of the world's largest Bonefish. For fly and spin anglers seeking the challenge of a lifetime, the 'ghost of the flats' presents one of the most thrilling fly fishing and spin fishing opportunities out there.

The huge bonefish (known locally as Kiokio) of the Aitutaki lagoon is a challenge to catch. Itu (pronounced E2) Davey, founder of Bonefish E2's Way, along with his younger brothers and his nephew, are your experienced local guides for the day.

Your guides hold extensive knowledge of the flats and fish spotting abilities which help tip the odds in your favour. E2 and his brothers are second generation Bone fisherman instilled with the great knowledge of the bonefish of the Aitutaki Lagoon by their father Richard. It is claimed that nobody knows the Bonefish of Aitutaki like the boys from the Davey clan.

Their charters cater for both fly and spin anglers and their main target species are Bonefish, Trevally and Giant Trevally (GT's) - all species landed in the lagoon are released. They happily welcome first timer (fishing) clients and experienced anglers.

In addition, E2 worked alongside local Marine Resources staff to set up reserves in the Aitutaki Lagoon for spawning and nursery areas for bonefish.

As part of the Bonefish Management Plan for Aitutaki and Manuae, all anglers must hold a 'Visitors Lagoon Fishing Permit' in order to do the tour. This can be obtained on the island of Aitutaki by guests a day before or on the day of fishing (please note cash sales only). Prices are per person in New Zealand dollars and vary: \$10 for 1 day, \$50 for 1 week, \$80 for 2 weeks and \$150 for 1 month. Please note prices are subject to change.

To purchase a fishing permit you can visit any one of the following outlets on Aitutaki; The Boat Shed Bar & Grill, Ministry of Marine Resources, Tamanu Beach Resort, Bank of the Cook Islands or the Aitutaki Island Council Chamber. All outlets are open daily from Monday to Sunday except for the Bank of the Cook Islands and the Aitutaki Island Council Chamber, which are only open from Monday to Friday.

The tour operator highly recommends that guests wait on the morning of the fishing charter to purchase their permit, due to some unforeseen circumstances such as bad weather, as the permits are non-refundable and non-transferable.
